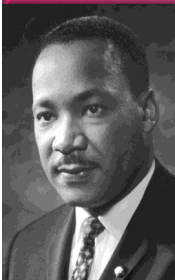

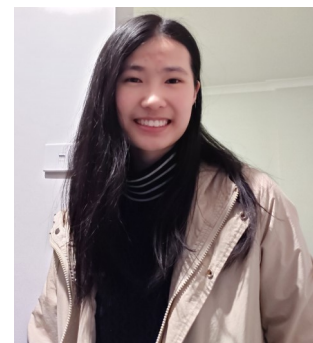


Jason Terry: President
