The second speaker, Thanya, introduced the role of social media in her life and stressed its collaborative openness and benefit to relationships. She then proceeded to assess the social media against the background of disaster relief and refugee support through the four way test. Truth was essential; sending help assisted those less fortunate; communicating what was being done should build better communities, and using technology would be for all to benefit.

The Barrys, Lambert and Freeman, were the judges and awarded the contest to Thanya. Peter presented awards to both girls.

The Sergeant performed, and he did it well!

Michael Mahoney won the raffle, Tony Makin the heads and tails.

President Colin thanked the speakers, their supporters, the partners, Jill, Alison and Julie, also our guest John Fletcher, for their attendance. Next week is election night!
