- If your stall is not busy or you have too many helpers, please walk to another stall to see if they need help

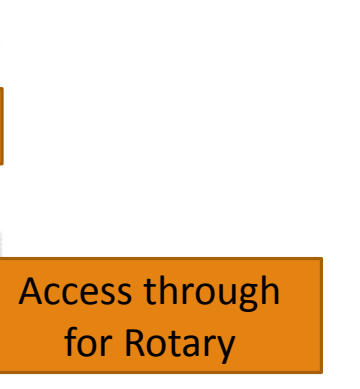
What do we wear?

- **Try to get your face painted on Sunday**

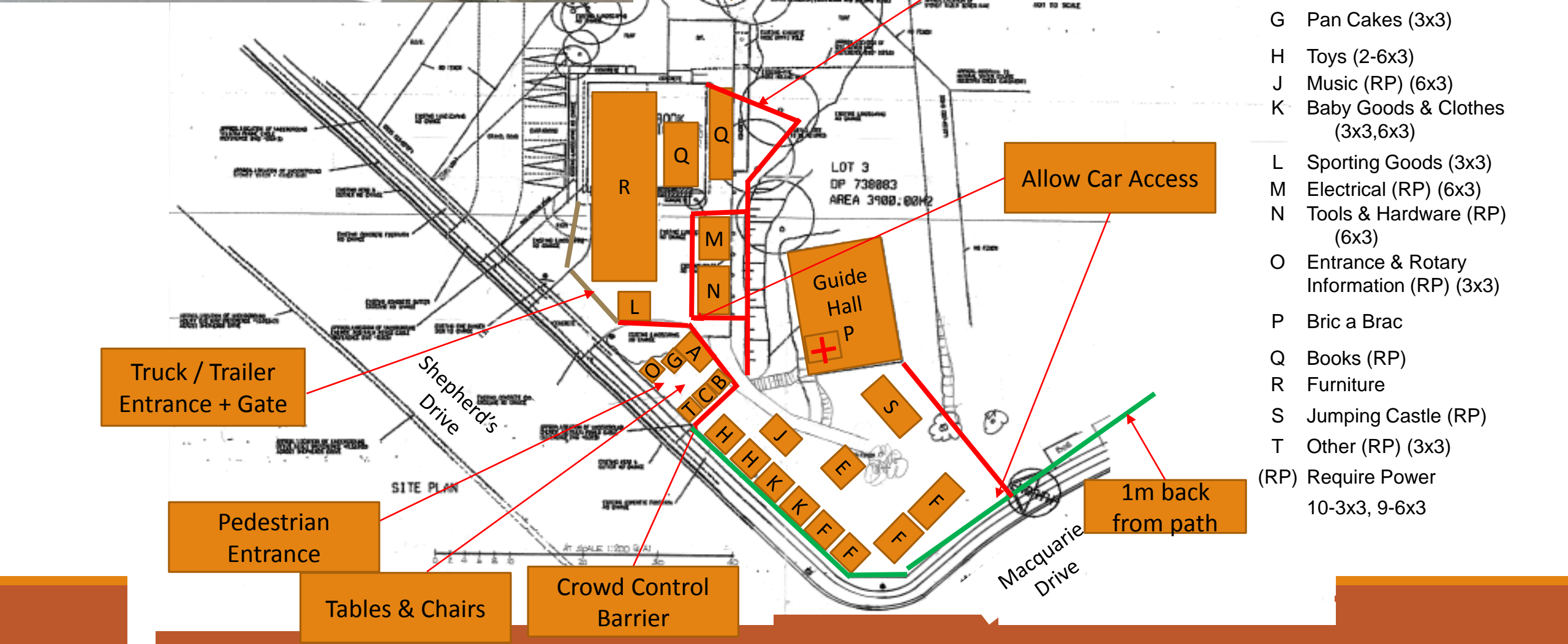


How Can You Help?
