### Ryde and Apia Clubs changing futures in the Pacific Region with Interplast



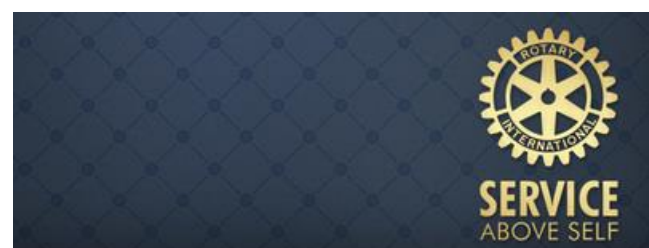
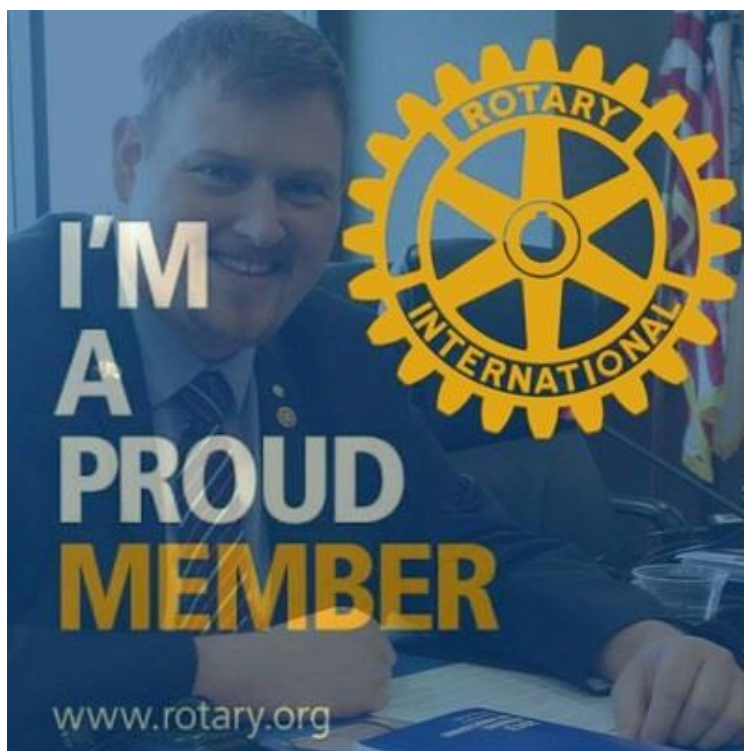
